

OVERVIEW

High Demand Hidden Careers (HDHC) is a state-funded grant program being offered to eligible participants to train and certify as a Research Administrator. BayTech has partnered with five institutions (Houston Methodist Academic Institute, University of Texas Medical Branch (UTMB), UTHealth-Houston, Rice University, and University of Houston) to offer this training and internship opportunity to 30 eligible candidates during the 2024-2025 grant year.

PROCESS

Once a candidate has gone through the application process and has been confirmed eligible, they will be matched with one of the five partnering institutions. Participants will complete a work-study internship for approximately 3 months. There will be online coursework, and depending on the location/rotation, students may be working on-site or remotely.

INITIAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Individual institutions may have additional eligibility requirements that will be outlined during their on-boarding process.

- U.S. Citizen or Authorized to Work in the U.S. (via Green Card)
- At Least 17 Years Old
- If a Male Under 26 Years Old: Registered in Selective Service
- Unemployed or Very Under-Employed
- Ready to Work
